HOW IS THIS GOING TO WORK?
The following are examples of how staff could benefit from a T.E.A.C.H. Scholarship Program. Let's bring the following to mind as we walk through an example of an Associate Degree Student's monthly wage digest:

- The Center is responsible for 75% of benefits.
- The student T.E.A.C.H. Scholarship is responsible for 15% of the tuition and books.
- T.E.A.C.H. pays 10% of tuition.
- The Center provides the Student 3 hours per week of paid time off (Release Time).
- The Center awards the Student a 15% raise in \$200 (three times after the completion of the contract).

\$200 per week for her release time	\$150 x 2 =	\$750
15% of her tuition	\$1500 x 15% =	\$225
10% of her tuition	\$1500 x 10% =	\$150
75% of her tuition	\$1500 x 75% =	\$1125
10% of her tuition	\$1500 x 10% =	\$150
All over the Center staff would:		\$1350

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?
It means that the cost of salaries and benefits for your employees meet their highest level of professional...

WHY DOES T.E.A.C.H. REQUIRE THE CENTER TO PROVIDE 3 HOURS OF RELEASE TIME?
Release time is a benefit that is provided to the student. They are most utilized in building their confidence and making professional gains as they develop through your professional partnership.

WAIT, REALLY?
Yes, really. T.E.A.C.H. will reimburse the Center \$150 per hour for the Release Time. This release time is to be provided to the student for a maximum of 3 hours per semester.

HOW IS THIS GOING TO WORK?
The following are examples of how staff could benefit from a T.E.A.C.H. Scholarship Program. Let's bring the following to mind as we walk through an example of an Associate Degree Student's monthly wage digest:

- The Center is responsible for 75% of tuition and 10% of books.
- T.E.A.C.H. pays 10% of tuition.
- T.E.A.C.H. awards you up to \$200 in Release Time after you complete a contract. Available 3 times after the completion of the contract.

Center will pay about \$200 per week. For this release time semester:	\$200
10% of her tuition	\$750
15% of her tuition	\$225
75% of her tuition	\$1125
10% of her tuition	\$150
Student tuition (Student fee) with additional support	\$1125
Amount T.E.A.C.H. would cover your staff semester:	\$1350
