Medicaid Unwinding Updates



Dear Families,

Below you will find information regarding the Medicaid Unwinding Updates that will affect millions of families across the state of Florida. Here is what you will need to know and do to be prepared for this process:

- Florida will begin the "renewal" process beginning on March 1st, 2023.
- After March 31st, the Department of Children and Families will follow federal income guidance in order to redetermine Medicaid eligibility while also working to ensure eligible individuals and families remain enrolled in the program.
- Terminating coverage for families who are determined to be ineligible will begin April 30th, 2023.



- If you are a Medicaid recipient, the Department will be making attempts to contact you via phone, email, mail, and/or text. Please ensure that your current contact information is up to date via the DCF My Access Portal.
- Be on the lookout in your mail for a yellow stripe envelope which will be your redetermination letter.
