

The Language of CLASS® Professional Learning Opportunities


Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) providers must annually participate in a program assessment of each VPK classroom per <u>Section 1002.68</u>, <u>Florida Statutes</u>. Program assessments measure the effectiveness of teacher-child interactions within the classroom. The Classroom Assessment Scoring System® (CLASS®) is the required program assessment tool.

The Division of Early Learning (DEL) offers two professional learning opportunities to support VPK directors and educators in the implementation of the CLASS®.
